

Sortland kulturskole is a public noncompulsory school - est. 1977 - and is subject to the Education Act of 1997, Section 13-6: 'All municipalities, either alone or in collaboration with other municipalities, must provide courses in music and other cultural activities for children and youths, organised in association with the school system and local cultural life.'

Thus – even if the school is open to everyone – the priority is children and youths up to the end of their teens.

The school do not request any prior knowledge, nor do we arrange any kind of entrance exam for attending the school.

The curriculum includes dance, drama, fine art and a variety of instrumental and vocal activities.

Applications are made online, and we accept applications continuously. But for the main admission, applications must be submitted by June 1st.

There is a tuition fee which is billed once per term, NOK 1375 (2023) each time for most activities.
